Specifications (white background, Size 3 x 4 cm)

- » All candidates applying for MBBS must meet the eligibility criteria stipulated in the guidelines issued by the Pakistan Medical Commission (PMC).
- » Foreign medical graduates must fulfill certain requirements, including passing the National Licensing Examination (NLE).
- » Duration of Course is 51/2 Years.
- » Hostel Mandatory for first year.

# **Eligibility Criteria**



## **Pre-Med Program**

- » Applicants must have completed their higher secondary School/Intermediate (10+2) with sufficient grades in physics, chemistry, biology, and mathematics.
- » At least 18 years old at the time of application.
- » Applicants are required to provide evidence of their English proficiency.

## **Med Program**

- » Candidates must have successfully completed a bachelor's degree or Pre-Med program with a cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- » In addition to English, at least two courses in biology, inorganic and organic chemistry, physics, and college mathematics are required as prerequisites.
- » MCAT within two years of the application deadline.
- » Applicants from non-English speaking countries might be required to provide proof of English proficiency through examinations such as the TOEFL or IELTS.
- » As an element of pre-medical preparation, supplementary coursework in anatomy, physiology, biochemistry, behavioral sciences, and other subjects that furnish a comprehensive foundation in the humanities may bolster the candidate's credentials.
- » Volunteer or professional experiences, work history, and community service are indicators of the student's motivation.

### **Offshore Campus MD Program:**

- » Track A: Students can complete 2.5 to 3 years of Pre-Med and Basic Sciences in Pakistan, followed by Clinical Rotations in Bridgetown, Caribbean. This track is designed for students aiming for international medical careers.
- » Track B: Students can complete their Basic Sciences and Pre-Med studies at BIU, followed by Clinical Rotations in Pakistan. This option is suited for students intending to return and practice or pursue postgraduate studies in Pakistan.

## **Transfer Applicants**

- » It is important for applicants to understand that the university does not automatically grant transfer credit for courses completed at other institutions.
- » The Admissions Committee, in conjunction with the Promotions Committee, shall determine the level of placement in the curriculum subsequent to an assessment of the official transcript.
- » Transfer applicants will not be eligible for admission to the university if they have been expelled from medical school.
- » The university will also deny admission to transfer candidates in their final year of clinical practice


### **Fee Payment Terms & Conditions**

#### 1. Payment Schedule :

- a. Tuition fees and Hostel fees must be paid in advance, as per the schedule specified by University.
- b. Prior to the commencement of each semester, students are required to settle all tuition and semester fees. Failure to make payment will, result in the student being ineligible to proceed to the next semester.
- c. Hostel fee is compulsory for the 1st year and must be paid before arriving to the destination country.
- d. For students opting for financial loan services, shall ensure the process is completed prior to their Travel conformation & get.
- 2. Late Payment & Penalties:
  - a. Failure to meet payment deadlines may result in late payment penalties or additional charges.
  - b. Upon obtaining a visa and officially commencing classes, students will be charged for one semester's fee.
- 3. Refund Policy:
- a. Refunds for tuition fees and other charges are subject to the university's refund policy and calculated on the basis of services availed by student.
